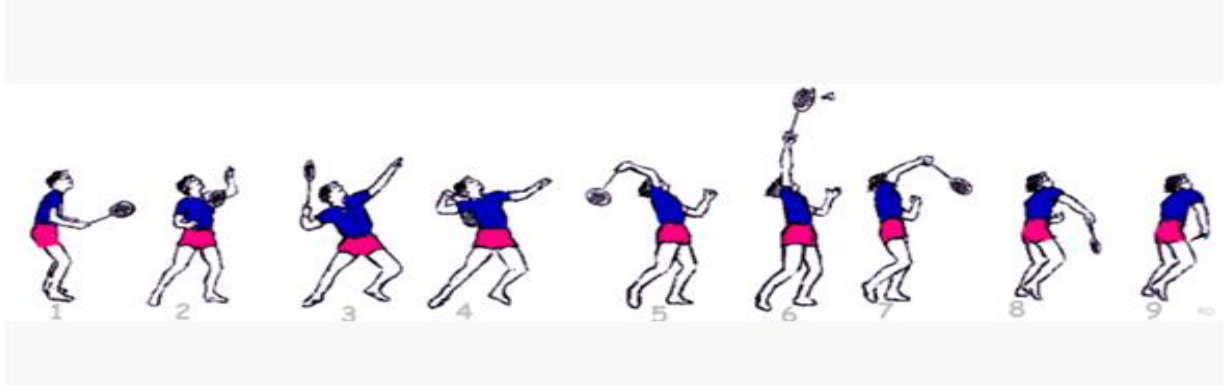


## Badminton Overhead Clear-Summative Assessment

<b>P</b>	The student scores 8 points in five overhead clear attempts
<b>C</b>	The student scores 7 points in five overhead clear attempts
<b>B</b>	The student scores 6 or fewer points in five overhead clear attempts

Description of Assessment	Diagram
<p>Students work in groups of three to complete the assessment.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Student one is the “recorder” who records scores, student two is the “setter” and student three is the “performer”.</li> <li>The “setter” hits a high underhand serve to the back ½ of the opposite court.</li> <li>The “performer” begins behind the baseline and moves into the back court and contacts the shuttle with an overhead clear stroke.</li> <li>The shuttle must be contacted behind the line designated on the diagram. The “performer” receives one point for a clear that is inbounds in the front 1/3 of the court or in the center of the back court.</li> <li>Two points are designated for a clear in which the shuttle lands in the right or left corners of the court.</li> <li>The “setter” hits five shots to the “performer” and the “recorder” records the number of points the “performer” receives. The students then switch positions.</li> </ul>
