
Badminton Overhead Clear-Summative Assessment

Description of Assessment Diagram Students work in groups of three to complete the assessment. • Student one is the "recorder" who records scores, student two is the "setter" and student three is the "performer". • The "setter" hits a high underhand serve to the back ½ of the opposite court. • The "performer" begins behind the baseline and moves into the back court and contacts the shuttle with an overhead clear stroke. The shuttle must be contacted behind the line designated on the diagram. The "performer" receives one point for a clear that is inbounds in the front 1/3 of the court or in the center of the back court. • Two points are designated for a clear in which the shuttle lands in the right or left corners of the court. The "setter" hits five shots to the "performer" and the "recorder" records the number of points the "performer receives. The students then switch positions.
